 CO Civil Rights Division concluded there is no basis for pursuing further legal action; appeal TBD based on potential new information.

CEO's Report

Return to Soccer – Advisory committees have been integral in putting together guidelines; no new information at this time beyond what has already been sent to clubs

- Awaiting further guidelines from the Governor's office.

Referee registration fees waived for 2021 for all paid-in-full referees for the 2020 calendar year

CSA has agreed to a 3-year extension agreement with Got Soccer to provide online registration and risk management platform for all CSA players and events.
