US Soccer Grassroots Referee –

Fast Track process for Licensed/Experienced coaches and former referees

Step 1: Create an account at the US Soccer Learning Center

Go to <https://learning.ussoccer.com/#!/sign-up>

- Create your account as a Referee or both Coach and Referee

Step 2: Email RefEducation@ColoradoReferees.com to request access.

In the email, include your coaching or officiating experience (licensing)

Step 3: Watch for an email from the Learning Center with your personal registration link.

- Follow the link to register for our 'fast track' course
- Pay the registration fee, which includes a REQUIRED background check*
- Update your SafeSport certification**

Step 4: Do the online lessons for your training session

There are several online lessons you must complete before attending your in-person training.

These are located in your course's classroom at the US Soccer Learning Center and include:

- Intro to Healthy and Safe Playing Environments
- Grassroots Referee Online Module (Noggin Labs)
- First Time Grassroots Referee Quiz
