You were able to proactively read the game, which allowed you to be at a good position when needed.

Your advantage call in the 64' minute was spot on. this directly led to an AFC goal opportunity.

Use your voice and body language to assist in your game management as needed. Becoming more animated will allow others to know what you are attempting to betray.

Be aware of the severity of possible head injuries when a player's head strikes the ground.

Players are certainly allowed to celebrate goals, but more management of these celebrations could have helped keep the game temperature a little more under control.

Justification of Difficulty and Scoring

Match(Game) Difficulty for this Official

The degree of difficulty should reflect the demands made on the official during the whole match and the assessor should take into consideration the circumstances during the match. Previous expectations or incidents should not be born in mind. The behaviour of players, coaches, officials, and spectators as well as special incidents, etc. have to be taken into consideration.

The degree of difficulty has a direct link with the final mark.

If the match became highly difficult because of the referees' blatant errors or lack of control his/her performance has to be considered POOR. On the contrary, the referee's and/or assistant referees' marks benefits if, because of their good performance, both teams behaved well and fairly after a high difficulty start. In this case the performance will be considered GOOD or VERY GOOD.

If an error influences the outcome of the match, the mark given must not exceed 7.5 in any circumstances.


