

Justification of Difficulty and Scoring

Match(Game) Difficulty for this Official

The degree of difficulty should reflect the demands made on the official during the whole match and the assessor should take into consideration the circumstances during the match. Previous expectations or incidents should not be born in mind. The behaviour of players, coaches, officials, and spectators as well as special incidents, etc. have to be taken into consideration.

The degree of difficulty has a direct link with the final mark.

If the match became highly difficult because of the referees' blatant errors or lack of control his/her performance has to be considered POOR. On the contrary, the referees' and/or assistant referees' marks benefits if, because of their good performance, both teams behaved well and fairly after a high difficulty start. In this case the performance will be considered GOOD or VERY GOOD.


