Moab FC Game-Day COVID Policies and Procedures

As per Grand County and Southeast Utah Health Department requirements to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

- 1. Please wear a mask or face covering when not able to maintain at least a 6-foot distance between others.
- 2. When entering the field, spectators will be required to write down their name and contact phone number and/or email. This will help with contact tracing if necessary.
- 3. Coaches must provide an extra copy of the team roster and/or list of names and contact phone number of players which will assist with contact tracing if necessary.
- 4. Please sit at least 6 feet from the sideline/painted line of the field. Households must sit minimum 6 feet from other households. Please bring your own chair if you wish to use, bleachers will not be provided.
- 5. All players will be asked if they have any COVID symptom or if they have been in contact with anyone with COVID symptoms in the last 14 days. If so, they will not be allowed on the field.
- 6. Temperature checks will be done on all players and coaches. Any player or coach with a temperature above 99 degrees will not be allowed on the field.
- 7. Masks will not be required of players while on the field, but will be required on the sideline/bench if not at least 6 feet distance between players.
- 8. Spectators are requested to enter the field no earlier than 15 min. before game time and to leave the field within 15 min after the game-over whistle.
- 9. Hand sanitizer will be available and must be used by players before and after substitutions. A hand sanitizing station will be on each side of the centerline of the field.
- 10. Players must be aware of minimizing player to player contact to fair, game-legal, game-play contact only. No handshakes, high fives, celebratory hugs or otherwise. Referee's will watch for illegal or 'over-touchy' off-ball contact and players in violation of contact rules will be given a penalty and or yellow card/red card by the referee (red card is dismissal from game.)
- 11. Individuals at high risk for COVID-19 are asked to NOT attend the game. If they insist there will be an area at the end line of the field where they may spectate, maintaining separation from others.
