



B-ELITE SOCCER ACADEMY - RETURN TO GAMES PROTOCOL

(Adapted from City of Aurora and Colorado Soccer Association)

GENERAL HEALTH MEASURES

1. Players, coaches, or spectators may not come to the field or facility if, in the last 14 days:
 - a. they have had a COVID-19 infection. In this case, they need a negative COVID-19 test and a doctor's note confirming they are cleared to participate.
 - b. they have been in contact with someone with COVID-19.
 - c. they show or have shown any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
 - d. they have had close, sustained contact with anyone who is sick.
2. Prior to entering the game pitch, every player & coach will be given a temperature check. If temperature is higher than 100.3 the player/coach will not be able to participate and will need to immediately leave the facilities.
3. Home & Away team coaches will administer a COVID-19 Health Declaration to their players & keep on file in case of illness. [CLICK HERE FOR THE ONLINE HEALTH DECLARATION](#) (coaches should have this with them at the game).

GAME DAY PROTOCOL - [CLICK HERE FOR GAME DAY FIELD SCHEMATIC](#)

1. Players can be dropped off at the facility 40 min prior to game time.
2. Parents/Spectators must wait in their vehicles until game time.
3. For all games, including games on turf, the warm-up area is on the West grass fields, to the south of Turf Fields 1 & 2.
4. Teams may only enter the game pitch once it is 100% cleared from the previous game and only through the designated entry where players & coaches will receive a temperature check.
5. Each player is allowed, **1 spectator**
 - a. In most cases, marking cones will be provided, but 6-foot social distancing must be maintained.
 - b. All spectators must wear masks
 - c. Under no circumstances can spectators enter the turf area.
 - d. On the turf fields at ASP, spectators are allowed on the grass hill to the South of the turf fields, on the grass area to the west of Field 1.
 - e. On grass fields at ASP, spectators are allowed behind the spectator line marking on the grass.
6. Home team and Away team will sit on opposite sides of the field, as outlined on the field schematic.
7. Players must wear masks **AT ALL TIMES**: when entering & exiting the facility, on the sideline and **while playing game**
8. Players may not share water bottles (no communal water jugs) and player's belongings (bag, water, etc) placed 6' apart
9. There will be no handshakes during coin flip or post-game. Use a wave or salute. High fives, chest bumps, or other direct contacts outside gameplay is discouraged.
10. Team benches are not allowed.
11. Avoid spitting (including sunflower or other shelled seeds).
12. Coaches and all Club Staff must wear masks the entire time on the premises, including on the sideline.
13. Coaches will disinfect all shared equipment after each game.
14. At the conclusion of the game, players & spectators must depart the field and proceed directly to their cars. There may not be post-game discussion on the field.
15. No tailgating or congregating in the parking lot or in any other place of the facility.
16. A maximum of 25 players can be on the field in the game within the boundary lines, excluding coaches and referees.

*If this protocol is not followed, B-Elite Academy and/or ASP Staff are permitted to invite the person(s) to leave the facility
